Literacy

We will be finishing off our story about a trip to the zoo, using all the techniques that we have learned in the last couple of weeks to enhance our writing. We will also be continuing to read our reading books, and practice common spelling words. If you'd like to practice at home, you could test your child on their words or get them to write them in interesting ways, such as in rainbow letters or back to front.
