Please note that false eye lashes and nails are not part of our uniform and children may be asked to remove these.

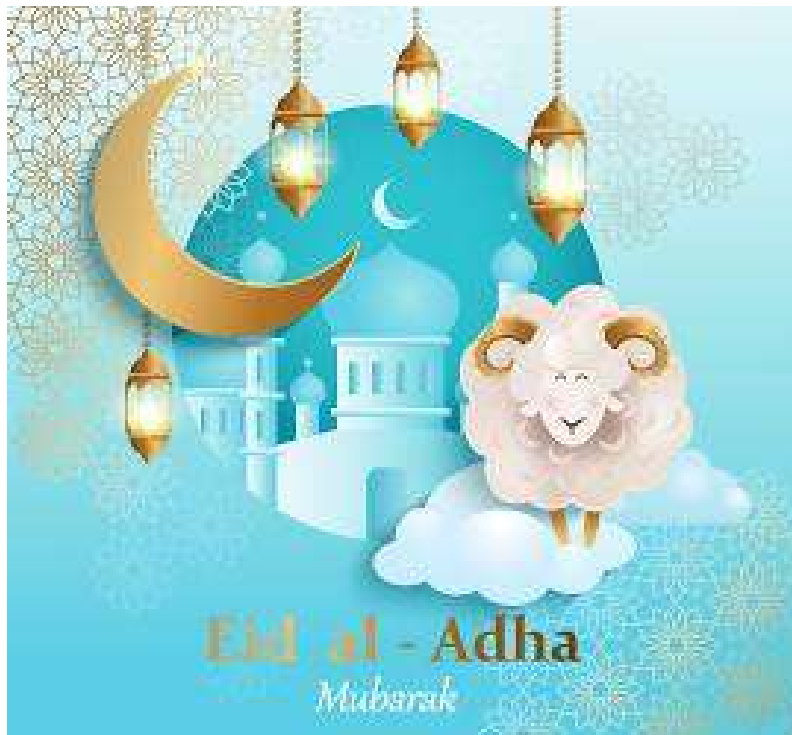

Lateness - Gates open at 0840 and close at 0850

Through our regular lateness and attendance monitoring we are sending out Late texts daily to any children who are not in class by **0850**.
