Phonics

Practise **reading** and **spelling** these words
To challenge, **write sentences** containing these words.

- Pink, link, rink, think, stink, blink.

Orcas and Sharks: recap of igh and ow

- Sigh, flight, fright, delight, spotlight
- Arrow, below, window, yellow, pillow

Numeracy

Numbers to 100(+)

- Practise **writing (forming) numbers** 1-9.
- Practise **identifying and writing numbers** from 1-30 and beyond to challenge.
- Practise **counting out-loud forward and backward to 50**, and beyond to challenge.

Addition

We have begun to look at addition in school. This week we are looking at 'subitising', which is being able to recognize number patterns without counting them.

At home, practice counting and combining different amounts of objects. Increase the number of objects to challenge. For example:

- 4 spoons + 2 spoons = spoons
- 12 leaves + 13 leaves =leaves
