- Practise **counting out-loud forward and backward to 50, and beyond to challenge.**

### Missing Number Subtraction

This week we are learning how to answer missing number subtraction number sums.

For example:  $25 - \underline{\quad} = 19$ .

To calculate the missing number, you need to count back from 25 to 19, to figure out what was subtracted from 25 (the answer is 6).
