Reading

Please read with your child at home.

Please bring reading folder to school daily. Please **write initials in reading record** to let us know you have practised reading.

Comprehension Focus

This week, we are learning about reading comprehension.

This means that when we read, we aren't just reading the words but understanding what they mean.

Activity

At home, pick any book - this could be a picture book, your school reading book, or another book of your choice.

Read the book, or a part of it, and **ask your child questions** about the book. Here are some questions you could ask them to practise reading comprehension:

- Who is/are the main characters?
- What did they do?
- Where did they do it?
- Why did they do it?
- Predict - what will they do next?
- What would you do if you were them?

Numeracy

Numbers to 100 (+)

- Practise **writing (forming) numbers 1-9**.
- Practise **identifying and writing numbers** from 1-50 and beyond to challenge.
- Practise **counting out-loud forward and backward to 100, and beyond to challenge**.

Money

We have been learning about money. We have been learning about pennies and notes up to £10.

If you have a chance, **visit a local shop, and practise reading the costs of items on the labels!**

Also, use this **game to practice recognizing, ordering and counting money!**
